Bottle

### Gnarly Dudes Shiraz, Two Hands, Barossa Valley Australia £38.95

After seeing the Gnarly Dudes on the Two Hands estate (one of the best in Australia) and then tasting the wine in their cellar, it remains a favourite of Chris's. You will not be disappointed. Big, brash, and unashamedly an Aussie Shiraz, from a multi-award-winning winemaker. Full bodied with fruit, chestnuts, burnt toffee, chocolate and lavender.

### Barolo, Natale Verga Italy £42.95

The king of Piedmont. Subtle notes of violet and pencil lead leading to black cherry fruit on the palate.

### The Chocolate Block, Boekenhoutskloof South Africa £45.95

Cult South African red from a renowned producer. Mainly Shiraz, so a black fruit and spicy palate, but softened out by blackcurrant from the Cabernet Sauvignon and a floral note from the white grape Viognier.

### Château Musar, Gaston Hochar Lebanon £48.95

No premium wine list is complete without this Lebanese classic. Surely one of the most interesting wines in the world, taste the Hochar family's take on classic Claret with a Bekaa Valley twist.

### Blushmore Zinfandel Rosé Italy £4.55 £6.15 £16.95

A medium-sweet rosé with flavours of strawberry and cream.

### Torre Alta Pinot Grigio Rosé Italy £4.95 £6.95 £17.95

A delicious and fruity rosé, with summer red fruit flavours. Very easy to drink.

### Ormilles Cotes De Provence France £24.95

Exploded in popularity in the last few years. A bottle of this and you are instantly transported from the Derbyshire hills to St Tropez.

Beautiful, slightly sweeter, lightly sparkling wine that every sip will make you crave for more, hints of strawberry, raspberry, blueberry and rhubarb.



# WHITE

**La Tierra Rocosa Sauvignon Blanc Chile** £4.75 £6.45 £16.95

A light, crisp, dry white from the sun-drenched vineyards of Chile. Delicious citrus and grapefruit flavours.

**Five Foot Track Chardonnay Australia** £4.75 £6.45 £16.95

A world away from the over-oaked, flabby Chardonnays that blighted us all in the 1990s. This is a much fresher wine, laden with tropical fruit.

**Malandrino Pinot Grigio Italy** £4.95 £6.55 £17.95

Everything you want in a Pinot – fresh, lemony with a tickle of pear drop flavour. A premium Pinot Grigio with much more character than most.

**Oltre Passo Falanghina Italy** £4.95 £7.85 £18.95

Feeling a little adventurous? Give this Falanghina a try and you won't be disappointed. From Puglia, the heel of Italy, this is a dry, stone-fruit packed zesty white.

**Grand Mayne Sauvignon, Côtes de Duras, Bordeaux, France** £5.50 £7.85 £20.95

Fruity and aromatic aromas of pear and white peach with a rich fresh citrus finish. A typical south western French Sauvignon.

**Camino Real Blanco Rioja Spain** £5.50 £7.85 £20.95

Rioja isn't just red wine! If you've never tried a white Rioja give this nutty, creamy, complex white a whirl.



**Picpoul Plo D'isabelle France** £5.70 £7.95 £22.95

From the fishing town of Pinet, as far south as you can go in France, this fresh, fruity white is perfect with all fish and seafood.

**Valle Berta Gavi Italy** £5.70 £7.95 £22.95

Often referred to as "The Italian Chablis", this is a bone-dry crisp white, with a characteristic aroma of lime zest and grapefruit, along with subtle hints of fresh fennel.

**El Cante Albariño Spain** £5.95 £8.10 £23.95

A fantastic example of an on-trend wine. From the seafood-mad area of Rias Baixas near Galicia, this has a zesty, limey backbone, and a delicious stone fruit character.

**Fairhall Cliffs Pinot Gris, Marlborough New Zealand** £5.95 £8.50 £24.95

Bursting with aromas of pear, honey, apple, spice and even a hint of cream. Traces of sweetness partner the pure fruit flavours, excellent with spiced dishes.

**Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough New Zealand** £6.10 £8.80 £25.95

Benchmark Marlborough Sauvignon, from a top producer. Extremely aromatic, full of pink grapefruit, gooseberry and (ironically) kiwi fruit flavours.

**Nord Est Vermentino, Sardegna Italy** £6.10 £8.80 £25.95

It's very rare to find Sardinian wines in the UK, they keep them for themselves! So we're delighted to have this on our list. Full of peach and citrus aromas with pear, stone fruit and lime on the palate.

**Chablis Cap St Martin, Burgundy France** £29.95

A complex, classically balanced Chablis full of citrus fruits. This wine has a beautiful soft mouthfeel and an incredibly long finish..

# RED

**Marques De Calado Tempranillo Spain** £4.75 £6.45 £16.95

A juicy and silky red from the grape that makes Rioja. Great-value wine from a quality focused estate.

**Big Bombora Shiraz Australia** £4.95 £6.95 £17.95

Deep, dark and full of spicy black fruit flavours. Perfect with red meat dishes.

**Two Ridge Trail Merlot Australia** £4.95 £6.95 £17.95

A deliciously soft and smooth Merlot. An inviting nose of plum and eucalyptus leads into a palate of blackberry and raspberry.

**Torre Cerere Montepulciano D'abruzzo Italy** £4.95 £7.80 £18.95

Like a Shiraz, but with an Italian twist. A dependable medium-bodied wine with lots of red cherry fruit, some peppery spice and soft supple tannins.

**Flor Del Fuego Cabernet Sauvignon Chile** £5.25 £7.80 £19.95

A fantastic example of a new world Cabernet. Plum and blackcurrant, with concentrated cassis and a subtle green-pepper-like savoury tinge.

**Grand Mayne Merlot Cabernet Côtes de Duras, Bordeaux France** £5.25 £7.80 £19.95

If you've not tried a wine from Duras, you must. Not a typical Bordeaux but a bit lighter. It's like having your nose in a basket of red fruit of blackcurrants and cherries. Soft, juicy and smooth with delicate tannins, very easy drinking.

**Oltre Passo Primitivo Salento Italy** £5.25 £7.80 £21.95

Like a warm hug in a glass of wine. A nose of prunes, dates and figs, with hints of sweet spice. Full and voluptuous, the mouth-feel is soft and plush, with toasty notes that linger on the finish.

**Sant'andrea Chianti, DOCG Italy** £5.25 £7.80 £21.95

A traditional Chianti, full of red cherry flavours and violets, with vibrant acidity, hints of sweet spices and a beautiful long, silky finish.

**Claro Reserva Carmenere Chile** £5.95 £7.95 £22.95

Merlot's more serious older brother. Spicy notes linger on the palate, with hints of dark chocolate and coffee, through the long, pleasant finish.

**'Sassaiolo' Rosso Piceno Superiore, Italy** £5.95 £8.10 £23.95

A combination of grapes that works just perfectly. Offers the elegance and structure of Sangiovese combined with the charming ripe fruit of the Montepulciano. Smooth and rich on the palate with a long, balanced finish.

**Marques de Laia Rioja Spain** £5.95 £8.50 £24.95

The king of wines in Spain. A complex and rich Rioja, with hints of vanilla and cinnamon.

**Capilla De Barro Malbec Argentina** £6.10 £8.80 £25.95

Superb with our steak. Delivers a swathe of ripe black fruit and blueberry held together by lush tannins.

**Fairhall Cliffs Pinot Noir New Zealand** £29.95



A classy, smooth Pinot Noir from the country that is giving top red Burgundies a run for their money. Brooding, intense aromas of black cherry and cassis in addition to spice, earth, brambles and a touch of mocha. The perfect wine to share if some of you are having fish, and some meat - a crowd pleaser!
