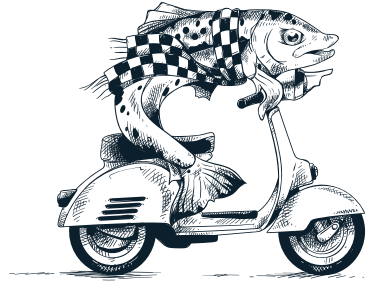

We are committed to keep evolving as a restaurant and as a result we are always on the lookout for new and exciting wines to share with you. Old world or new world, young or old, established, or unusual – if it's delicious it's in our list!

We believe that wine should be an experience and we're delighted to be able to offer you some of our favourite fine wines by the glass through our state of the art Coravin system. Not sure what to try? No problem, we can recommend the perfect wine to go with each course on the menu. Whenever we taste a new wine for the list, we always try and match it to one of the current dishes on our menu; a pairing between food and wine can make the whole dining experience even better.

Our passion for wine is driven by our desire to travel and experience some of these regions and countries, which has enabled us to meet some great producers in person. So much so that I've even brought some of my favourite wines back from my travels to share with you, such as the **Marco Cuscito** sparkling wines from Italy and the stunning pair of still wines from **Grande Mayne** in Côtes de Duras.

In our recent wine list update, we introduced a few new wines that I think will blow your socks off. My personal favourites of the new wines are an Italian duo - the **Nunzio Ghiraldi Lugana** from the hills around Lake Garda in Italy and the **Buontalenti Toscana**, which is a baby Super-Tuscan with its blend of Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon.

Sadly, there are going to be supply problems this year, which has also influenced some of our decisions. New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc is expected to be in short supply across the UK until the 2022 wines arrive, due to a combination of a poor harvest and the ability to sell wine at higher prices elsewhere in the world. Champagne is also expected to be more scarce this year, but we have a fine selection of bubbles on offer including two fantastic English wines.

SPARKLING WINE

125ML BOTTLE

CHAPEL DOWN SPARKLING BACCHUS KENT, ENGLAND

£38.00

Bacchus is the Ancient Greek god of wine. He's lent his name to what is now England's star grape. It's taken Chapel Down, official supplier to 10 Downing Street and the Oxford & Cambridge Boat Races, 18 years to perfect the art. But it's finally arrived. It's a glorious streak of pineapple, grapefruit and elderflower that runs through arrow-precise bubbles.

APERICENA PROSECCO ITALY

£6.50 £27.00

Delicate and aromatic with fine bubbles. This wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear and an elegant zest.

LOUIS POMMERY SPARKLING BRUT HAMPSHIRE, ENGLAND

£62.00

After a race between all of Champagne's biggest names to get here first, Pommery is the first house to launch English fizz. They apply the same traditional method used in Champagne. It's crisp and concentrated, with notes of waxy lemon, Granny Smith, freshly baked bread and honeycomb.

RUINART BLANC DE BLANCS CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

£110.00

Grand Cru Chardonnay has been used to make this Champagne. Citrus, peach and white flower aromas evolve into a fresh and supple palate, ideal when married with seafood.

RUINART ROSÉ CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

£110.00

Ruinart Rose was first released in 1962. It is the blanc de blanc to which 15% Pinot has been added. Sublime golden pink in colour, a subtle nose of cherry and freshly-picked red berries leads to a fleshy and delightfully smooth finish.

MARCO CUSCITO

Small estate wine maker Marco Cuscito is a personal friend of ours who visits a few times a year and we are extremely fortunate to be able to have this amazing range of sparkling wines. In fact we are the only place in the UK to have it as we get direct from Marco. DOCG means it's the best quality, 100% Glera grape grown on the hillside is instrumental for him producing wine with hardly any sugar. Light floral notes with peach, apple, aromatic subtle effervescence giving them all a delicious clean finish.

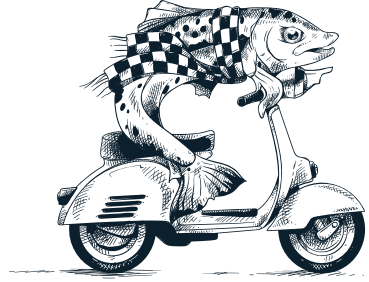

PROVENCE, FRANCE

An attractive and delicate honeysuckle pink wine with a lifted nose of summer fruits and tropical suggestions of mango. Intense, crisp, well balanced and refreshing on the palate.

EVEN BETTER IN A MAGNUM £81.00

BEL CANTO PINOT GRIGIO ROSÉ £6.95 £9.60 £26.00

ITALY

Soft pink in colour with a purplish hue. A balanced wine with fresh and pleasant notes of cherry red fruit and slightly ripe forest fruit.

CRESCENDO WHITE ZINFANDEL ROSÉ £7.50 £10.30 £28.00

ITALY

This wine is fresh, with aromas of red fruit and cream. Lovely balance between soft tannins, acidity and a touch of sweetness.

LION AND THE LILY ROSÉ £37.00

BORDEAUX, FRANCE

Bordeaux may be best known for its reds, but it was actually one of the original rose regions. Made from 100% Merlot, it has notes of wild strawberry and cherry alongside a fresh minerality.

PROVENCE, FRANCE

Meet the world's trendiest Provence pink, made by Sacha Lachine, a master of the art of rosé. Thanks to groundbreaking winemaking techniques, this vintage has fresh notes of apples, pink grapefruit, summer berries, rosewater, peach and cream, and a long, smooth finish.

ROSEBLOOD D'ESTOUBLON ROSÉ £6.25 £9.95 £13.95 £51.50

PROVENCE, FRANCE

Meet the new exquisite star of Provence, made by the master winemaker of Cloudy Bay himself. This wine is all about elegance, it has a distinctive mineral freshness, in which notes of apricot and peony express themselves freely on a citrus canvas, ending in elegant tension of the palate.

Coravin is a unique preservation pouring system that allows us to serve wines in any amount without allowing oxygen into the bottle as you never remove the cork. This means that you can preserve the remaining wine for weeks, months or even years to come.

Lifted peach and cream with lemon blossom, soft juicy palate and crisp cleansing finish make this an enjoyable easy drinking wine.

A fleshy white, with bright aromas of ripe apricot and peach, hints of grapefruit and fresh pineapple.

Fruity and aromatic aromas of pear and white peach with a rich fresh citrus finish. A typical south western French Sauvignon.

This wine is fresh, zesty and zippy. On the nose there are notes of white flowers, and on the palate tropical and stone fruits.

ITALY

Subtle traces of honeysuckle with characteristic aromas of lime zest and minerality. It offers a clean and refreshing finish.

1697 GRILLO SICILIA, ORGANIC

ITALY

The Grillo grapes are chilled once they've been picked to retain their vibrant aromatics. The wine is then rested on its lees (natural yeast particles) – this softens the texture and introduces extra depth to the flavour.

TEIXADAL TREIXADURA

SPAIN

Refreshing Treixadura grapes lend plenty of nectarine and citrus fruit aromas. A satisfying complexity thanks to the wine settling on its lees for a while before bottling.

TUSCANY, ITALY

Terre del Buontalenti is typical 'Super Tuscan' blend of Sangiovese, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. Aged in oak for 18 months, it has bright red and black fruit aromas, elegant hints of spice and succulent tannins.

MOZZAFIATO PRIMITIVO

ITALY

Flavours of dried prune, date and plump cherry, with swathes of sweet spice. A mouth coating, chocolatey red wine.

Notes of cedar and vanilla follow on to the silky smooth finish that lingers on the palate with the black currant and plum.

Formidable Pinot Noir, red fruit dominant with cherry and raspberries on the nose, baking spices come through to join the fruit on the palate and linger on the finish.

APERICENA APPASSIMENTO

ITALY

Intense red in colour, with a complex bouquet reminiscent of cherries, raspberries and redcurrants. Full-bodied, it is supple and well-balanced.

TWO HANDS 'GNARLY DUDES' SHIRAZ

AUSTRALIA

Intense and complex on the nose, which offers an array of fruit accented by notes of chestnuts, burnt toffee, chocolate and lavender. Full and lush on the palate, with a supple texture and good length.

AOC VENTOUX AIME ARNOUX, ORGANIC

RHONE, FRANCE

Rich and complex, this wine is classic Rhône: a blend of Grenache, Syrah, Carignan, Mourvèdre and Cinsault. With plenty of intense red-fruit aromas and spicy nuances, it's a real reflection of the sunny limestone plateau on which the vineyards are located.

LANGUORE SANGIOVESE

ITALY

Intense ruby red in colour with typical scents of ripe cherry and raspberry. It is medium bodied, juicy, fresh and persistent.

FIVE RAVENS PINOT NOIR

Romania may not be the first place you think of when you are looking to buy a Pinot Noir but this has all the classic bright red fruit flavours and spicy notes you would expect.

DEHESA DE GAZANIA RIOJA RESERVA

RIOJA, SPAIN

Exhibiting luscious bramble fruit, partnered with a spicy complexity, herbaceous notes and flavours of liquorice.

Silky smooth wine with lashings of blackcurrant, bramble and white pepper notes on the finish.

CRESCENDO MERLOT

GRAND MAYNE MERLOT CABERNET SAUVIGNON

CÔTES DE DURAS, FRANCE

If you've not tried a wine from Duras, you must. Not a typical Bordeaux but a bit lighter. It's like having your nose in a basket of red fruit of blackcurrants and cherries. Soft, juicy and smooth with delicate tannins, very easy drinking.

DOMAINE DES TOURELLES 'CUVÉE PIERRE BRUN'

BEKAA VALLEY, LEBANON

Founded in 1868, Tourelles is Lebanon's oldest winery. A blend of Cabernet, Syrah, Cinsault and Carignan, this has fine aromatic morello cherry and spice aromas, a dark fruit core with layered earthy spice, and balanced tannins.

WISDOM TREE DAO

PORTUGAL

Delightfully soft and rounded, this wine is full of plum and bramble flavours with touches of herbs and a slight spiciness to the finish.

DOMINIO DE LA FUENTE ORGANIC GARNACHA

SPAIN

A juicy, fleshy unoaked red wine, showing great purity and the typicity of high-altitude Garnacha from the heart of Spain, with expressive and well-defined aromas of red fruits and violets. Bright ruby red colour. Fresh and with an excellent persistence on the palate..

PAZOS DE LUSCO ALBARINO

RIAS BAIXAS, GALICIA, SPAIN

Albarino doesn't get much better than this! Pazos de Lusco retain that classic freshness, whilst achieving the most amazing intensity and texture in their wines. Aromas of apple, pear and peach complemented by floral notes. The wine is rounded and harmonious on the palate, with citrus notes and a balance of refreshing acidity and ripe flavours. A structured, elegant wine.

DOMAINES SCHLUMBERGER PINOT GRIS GRAND CRU 'SPIEGEL'

ALSACE FRANCE

A wine of great texture and depth of flavour, this Pinot Gris is at once youthfully vibrant, harmonious and mature. The palate is full of ripe white fruit, with finely balanced sweetness and acidity.

PIEROPAN SOAVE CLASSICO

VENETO, ITALY

This is a remarkable example of why Soave Classico is a completely different sip from what you'll find from the Soave crowding supermarket shelves. The Pieropan estate was the first to ever make a single vineyard Soave. Today, they make this organic expression on the hillsides in the heart of the Soave Classico area. Left on texture-building lees, it's fresh and expressive with notes of white flowers, almond and marzipan, a fresh, clean acidity and hints of pastry on the finish.

DUC ARMAND SANCERRE

LOIRE, FRANCE

Sancerre is where you'll find some of the world's most prestigious Sauvignon. It's some of the globe's best, and most exclusive, white wine. The 25 year old vines producing this elegant dry white, create aromas of white flowers and green apple and refreshing citrus flavours.

STAGS LEAP HANDS OF TIME CHARDONNAY £7.00 £11.15 £15.25 £57.00
CALIFORNIA, USA

Stag's Leap creates some of the very finest wines in America. The Hands of Time is a chance to taste its world-famous expertise without paying a three-figure sum. Mainly fermented in vanilla-imparting oak and aged on texture-gifting lees, this Chardonnay boasts aromas of pear and pineapple, a soft palate and a smooth acidity.

PETALUMA 'HANLIN HILL' RIESLING £7.40 £11.70 £16.05 £60.00
CLARE VALLEY, AUSTRALIA

Clare Valley is one of Australia's oldest wine regions and to this day, it's most famed for its remarkable Riesling. Petaluma is one of the region's leading wineries. They carefully choose their vineyards to make the most of the region's amazing grape-growing conditions. Their 'Hanlin Hill' Riesling is a delightful potpourri of lemon, lime, stone fruits, tropical notes and that all-important whiff of kerosene. It's pin-point precise and balanced by a snappy acidity.

DOMAINE CHATELAIN CHABLIS
1ER CRU 'FOURCHAUME' £7.60 £12.10 £16.60 £62.00
BURGUNDY, FRANCE

Fourchaume is one of the most acclaimed spots in Chablis. Exposed to the rising sun, vines here see bucketloads of grape plumping hours. Domaine L. Chatelain's is a prime example. On the nose, it emits delicate hints of almond, butter and licorice. The palate is round and buttery with flavours of citrus, marmalade and toasted almond.

CORAVIN RED

MENDEL 'SPECIAL SELECTION' MALBEC MENDOZA, ARGENTINA

Mendel own some of the oldest vineyards in Argentina including their 'Finca M' vineyard, which is 80 years old. They have selected the finest grapes from this vineyard plus two others to blend this wine. Expect notes of violets, a mix of deep red and black fruit, a touch of spice and a luxurious dark chocolate note on the finish.

RESERVE DES DENTELLES RHÔNE, FRANCE

Châteauneuf-du-Pape makes a strong claim as the world's finest wine. Thanks to the region's soils nourishing the juiciest Grenache and Syrah grapes, you'll find a spicy, robust red like this nowhere else. This extravagant garnet-red wine emits punchy notes of forest fruits, seasonal spices and mocha. It's silksmooth with powerful fruit intensity and seemingly endless depths of complexity.

BOEKENHOOTSKLOOF 'THE CHOCOLATE BLOCK' WESTERN CAPE, SOUTH AFRICA

Boekenhootskloof's winemaker is tight-lipped about how the wine is made, but that only adds to its mystique. He tweaks the blend slightly with every vintage so no two Chocolate Blocks are quite the same. But it's always a blend of rich and ripe Mediterranean varieties: Syrah, Grenache, Cinsault and Cabernet Sauvignon, with a touch of Viognier for added perfume. It's seriously plush, packed with dark berry fruit. Think plums, blackberries, blueberries and cherries, backed up by earthy, rustic leather, earth and spice notes.

DUCKHORN 'DECOY' ZINFANDEL SONOMA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA USA

This rich and alluring Zinfandel displays aromas of ripe blackberry, wild blueberry, plum and black currants, along with hints of cedar and spice from barrel aging. On the palate, the luxurious dark berry flavors glide across velvety tannins, carrying the wine to a long, juicy finish.

CORAVIN RED

LA RIOJA ALTA 'VIÑA ARDANZA' RESERVA RIOJA, SPAIN

La Rioja Alta produce some of the finest wines in Spain, using the utmost care at every stage of the winemaking process - every single grape is plucked by hand when it reaches perfect ripeness. You need no further testament than to know that our wine merchant has a magnum of this wine on his Christmas table every year. It's made from 30-year-old vines and aged for three years in oak. This brings you an indulgently rich Reserva with silk-smooth tannins and complex aromas of vanilla, cinnamon and liquorice. The perfect match for roast beef.

CIABOT BERTON BAROLO PIEDMONT, ITALY

Showing a splendid ruby red colour this wine is characteristic of Barolo with its high acidity and fleshy tannins. With classic aromas of rose petals and tar and high levels of plummy fruit.

MASI 'COSTASERA' AMARONE CLASSICO VENETO, ITALY

Amarone is one of the most regulated DOCGs in Italy. Producers aren't even allowed to pick their grapes until they're given official approval. The grapes are dried on special bamboo racks. They're then fermented for eighty days - about double the standard time - and matured in Slovenian oak. Prune, fig and chocolate are the backbone to this complex & beguiling wine. Every sip discovers another beautiful flavour.

CIDER

Somerset is apple country, with the perfect soil and climate for growing apples and making cyder. It has been going on here for centuries. Head out to the small farmlands of Somerset and you'll spot ancient orchards still dotted about; clumps of mistletoe in the canopy, sheep grazing under the dappled shade of laden trees. Old barns still with the farmer's cyder press within, some still making cyder today. At The Newt, they celebrate every aspect of their county's signature crop; from the sapling to the tree, the fruit, its juice and the final stage: cyder.

Around the time Hadspen House was built, the finest quality cyders were preferred to Champagne by sniffy Somerset gentry who knew their tippie. People in our apple-growing regions consumed over a pint a day; at the time, this mildly alcoholic drink was safer than water. Everyone, including children, drank it – even at breakfast! Records show that the secondary fermentation process being used at this time - in glass bottles, sealed with corks - came well before French monk Dom Pierre Pérignon supposedly invented Champagne.

THE NEWT FINE WHITE CIDER 8.1% (BOTTLE)

£29.95

Made with specially selected dessert apples using precise wine-making techniques and slowly cold fermented in their cellar. The result is a super-fresh elegant, still cyder; you can expect ripe pear, melon and almond on the nose, with a crisp taste of apple and lemon.

THE NEWT ICE CIDER 8.2% (375ML BOTTLE)

£35.00

It's cyder, but not as you know it. Just in from Greg and the team in the Cyder Cellar is a rich and super sweet Ice Cyder, perfect with pudding or a wedge of Westcombe cheddar. It's comparable to a fine dessert wine, with a lovely fresh note of citrus on the nose and palate.

Originating from Canada, Ice Cyder is made by pressing apples while they are still frozen. The water from the apples turns to ice and is separated, leaving only the intense, syrup-like juice behind.

Having been inspired by this technique, the team have recreated the same freezing conditions on the estate by storing their freshly pressed apple juice at -25°C for a minimum of five weeks. The sweet, naturally concentrated syrup is then cold fermented in their cellar and aged in steel tanks for a further six months, before it's bottled and ready to drink.

THE NEWT WINSTON 2018 (568ML BOTTLE)

£55.00

"An imperial pint is an ideal size for a man like me. It's enough for two at lunch and one at dinner. It pleases everyone, even the producer", – so says the distinguished British Prime Minister who inspired The Winston, the first sparkling cyder in the world to be bottled as an imperial pint. The apples that went into the making of this special sip were picked and pressed in 2018, before being fermented in our cellar by Head Cyder Maker Paul Ross, and laid down in bottle for two years. The result? A vibrant cyder with a pale straw colour and fine mousse. Candy, brioche and custard apple on the nose, with lychee, mango and crisp apple to taste.

THE NEWT APPLE GIN 40%
